What is Food Share Wisconsin?

- A food and nutrition program food benefit based on the number of persons in a household and the total monthly net household income.
- Once eligible, a QUEST card, (form of a debit card) is issued enabling the purchase of eligible groceries at participating stores.
- Food stamps are available to most low-income households with few resources, regardless of age, disability status, or family structure

Why Applying for Food Stamps (Food Share) is a good idea?

- Lowers grocery bills so you can save that money for rent
- This will mean less worry about choosing between feeding your family or paying rent.

Average Food Stamp Benefit:

- A food stamp recipient receives 78 cents per meal, on average.
